Registration is now open for the 24-hour initial training and 8-hour refresher course through the FWAA Website, [www.fwaa.org](http://www.fwaa.org), under the Events and Registration tab, Safety Training. Here are the dates for the training:

**Tuesday, March 21, 2017: 8 Hour Refresher Training**

**Wednesday, March 22 and Thursday March 23, 2017: 24 Hour Initial Training**

Registration will be accepted on a first-come/first-served basis until the maximum class size of 40 participants is reached for each class. Registration ends on March 17<sup>th</sup> so that the first eight hours of the instructional book study and exam can be completed prior to the on-site 16-hour training for the 24-hour course.

If classes reach their maximum, a wait list will be taken and you will be notified if we have a cancellation and also when the next scheduled training will take place.

**Important note:** This training will be held at the Far West Agribusiness facility located at 5805 W. Thorpe Road, Spokane, Washington. Those beyond driving distance are encouraged to make flight reservations at least 2 weeks in advance in order to receive the most favorable rates. Included in your registration will be a catered lunch and break refreshments. We are currently working to schedule another training in southern Idaho around the June time period and a final training in Silverton, Oregon around the September time period.
