The Washington State Department of Ecology has listed Ammonium Sulfate on the state Toxic Air Pollutant list and in July, 2017, FWAA filed a petition for its removal. As part of the Rules process to remove it, there will be a public stakeholders meeting from 10:00 AM until Noon on Monday, December 10, 2018 at the Three Rivers Convention Center, 7016 West Grandridge Blvd, Kennewick, WA 99336.
